

Manufacturer's Declaration of Conformity

Flexicon manufactures more than 97% of its products in its own factory at Roman Way, Coleshill, Birmingham, B46 1HG, UK.

All products in Flexicon's latest product guide meet the essential requirements of the European Low Voltage Directive 2014/35/EU and are therefore entitled to carry the CE mark.

All products in Flexicon's product guide meet the requirements of the European and IEC standard for flexible conduit systems, BS EN IEC 61386-23, pliable conduit systems BS EN IEC 61386-22 and the general conduit requirements in BS EN IEC 61386-1.

All products in Flexicon's product guide meet the European RoHS directive 2011/65/EU, restriction of Hazardous Substances, including EU directive 2015/863 DEHP (phthalate) free.

Flexicon declares that all products supplied conform to the Directive 2015/863 (RoHS 3) and can confirm that they do not contain any of the 205 entries listed in the SVHC candidates list of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 - Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) as at 16 January 2020.

In addition, they do not contain any Conflict Minerals.

The European WEEE directive, Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment, is not applicable to Flexicon's products.

All of Flexicon's products fall under its ISO 9001 accreditation for the design and manufacture of flexible and pliable conduit systems and associated accessories. Flexicon is accredited to ISO 9001 2015 by BSI, certificate number FM58347. Flexicon's quality system is also accredited by Intertek, for the manufacture of ATEX and IECEx hazardous glands, and by SGS to the International Rail Industry Standard IRIS.

Other organisations that regularly assess Flexicon's quality systems and manufacturing facilities include UL (underwriters Laboratories) and Lloyds Register of Shipping.
